

# SINGLE IRISH CHAIN

12½" unfinished

Light Yellow Background plus  
Medium Purple

For one block:

8 - 2½" purple squares OR 1 - 2½ x 20" purple strip (a little longer would be safer)

1 - 4½" purple square

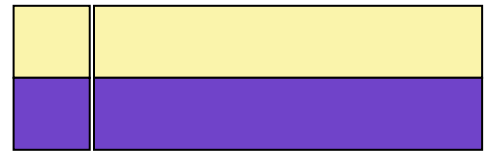
8 - 2½" light yellow squares OR 1 - 2½ x 20" light yellow strip (a little longer would be safer)

4 - 4½" light yellow squares

1. Sew the small purple squares and small light yellow squares into a 4-patch. Press seams toward the purple squares where you can. Make 4.

OR

Sew the two strips together and press the seam toward the purple strip. Cut the strip set into 8 - 2½ x 4½" sections, then sew pairs together into 4-patches. Make 4.



2. Referring to the picture above, sew a 4½" light yellow square between two 4-patches. Press toward the light yellow square. Make two rows.

3. Sew a purple square between two light yellow squares. Press toward the light yellow squares.

4. Sew the light yellow+purple+light yellow row between the two 4-patch rows, again referring to the picture for placement.
