

Cat Face Block

6 ½" x 6 ½"

Cut 1 - 2 ¼" x 6 ½" Rectangle, Background Fabric for bottom of face

Cut 1 - 2 ¼" x 6 ½" Rectangle, Cat Fabric for top of face

Cut 2 - 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" Squares, Background Fabric for face

Cut 2 - 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" Squares Cat Fabric for ears

Cut 1 - 3" x 6 ½" Rectangle, Cat fabric for face

Draw diagonal lines on the back side of all squares.

Sew along diagonal line of cat ear fabric square to one end of background fabric 2 ¼ x 6 ½ rectangle and repeat on opposite end.

Sew along diagonal line of background fabric square to one end of cat face fabric 2 ¼ x 6 ½ rectangle and repeat on opposite end.

Sandwich and sew cat face 3 x 6 ½" rectangle between the ear and chin rectangles.

You can embellish your cat face with buttons, or fusible eyes and stitch on some whiskers as well.



Your cat face will be a bit thicker than mine as I was not happy with the thinness of my cat face.
