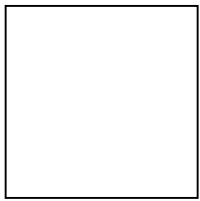


Friendship Star

Instructions to make ONE $9\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished block



From White Background, cut
(4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

(2) 4" squares

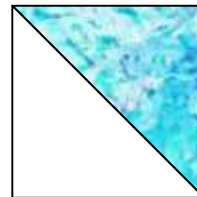
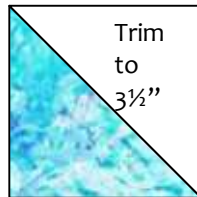
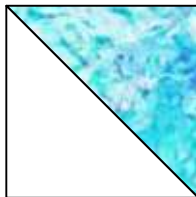
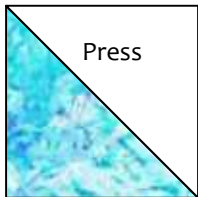
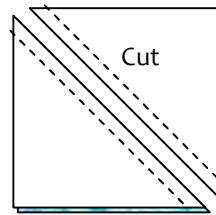
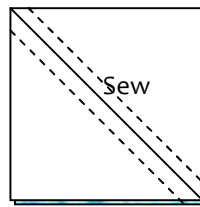
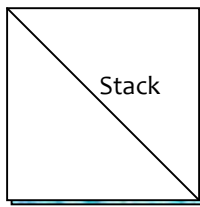
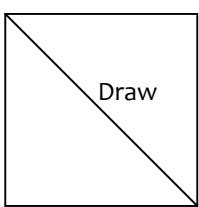


From Floral Print, cut
(1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square

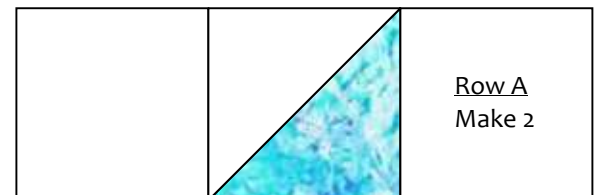
(2) 4" squares

Piecing

Using the "Two at a Time Method", make (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " HSTs using the 4" squares:



Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew two (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " White squares on either side of an HST, as shown.



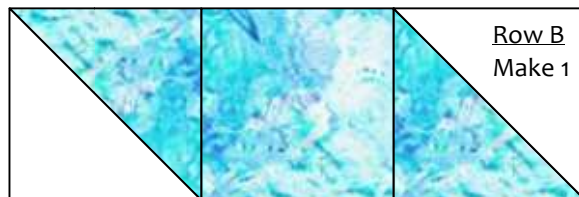
Press seams away from the HST.

Tip: Measure each row as you go, so you can adjust your seams as necessary to reach the desired size.

Row A should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Repeat to make two (2) rows.

Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew an HST on either side of a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown. Press seam away from the HSTs.



Row B should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Nesting seams, sew Rows A and Row B together with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Press seams open. The Friendship Star Block should now measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Print your name on the block, as shown.
